XBRL – QUOI DE NEUF EN EUROPE ?

- ▶ Panorama XBRL s'étend largement en Europe
- ▶ Autorités Européennes (EBA, EIOPA, ECB, NCAs and MS) ont consolidé/étendu leurs projets dans les secteurs supervisés.
- ▶ Nouveaux projets possibles à venir comme Anacredit de la BCE
- ▶ ESMA considère sérieusement XBRL et pourrait annoncer des décisions XBRL dans les prochaines semaines après 2 consultations en 2015 EEAP & ESEF -> Développement majeur des prochaines années

XBRL – QUOI DE NEUF EN EUROPE ?

- ▶ Les Conclusions de la CBA
- ▶ Transparency directive : “A harmonised electronic format for reporting would be very beneficial for issuers, investors and competent authorities, since it would make reporting easier and facilitate accessibility, analysis and comparability of annual financial reports”.
- ▶ XBRL and iXBRL are the most beneficial options (and less costly) and are better aligned with the objectives of the TD in terms of information improvement and technological facility.
- ▶ Adoption of XBRL or iXBRL : to foster the achievement of the objectives of the TD and result in an enhancement of the attractiveness of EU capital markets and an increase in the investment flows

XBRL – QUOI DE NEUF EN EUROPE ?

- ▶ Au niveau des Etats Membres les Secteurs « classiques » nationaux (Business registers, Tax departments, Statistics, others) continuent de s'étendre en XBRL aussi (certains avec pour certains des vues de type SBR)

 - Agenda Digital : “Data is at the centre of the future knowledge economy and society, Availability of good quality, financial data, ...”
 - Capital Market Union: More efficient approaches towards supervisory and market reporting, to develop common IT approaches & Common, and high quality accounting standard tailored to the companies listed on certain trading venues (...) especially for SMEs, making such companies more attractive to cross-border investors.
